FEES COMMITMENT BY PARENT

1. Christian High School is a fee paying private/independent school and therefore reserves the right to terminate registration or access to the school for any learner due to non-payment of fees unless reasonable arrangements have been made to bring the account up to date. Arrangements can only be made once a year only for one month and should be honoured . If the account is not honoured it will be handed over to CBN debt collectors.
2. Admission and registration in the school implies that the learner has been allocated space in the school and resources are assigned towards that learner, deregistration is therefore only possible in the first two weeks of registration after which learners will be liable to the full fees. **The registration fee is non-refundable.**
3. Fees are payable on the 1st day of each month unless other arrangements have been done and agreed upon by the parents and school.
4. Under no circumstances may cash be paid to anybody at the school, all payments must be made at the bank. Parents are advised to do payments themselves to avoid money being lost or misused by learners.
5. Access card – after registration the learner will be given access card and must always carry it with her/him.
 - If left at home, the learner s to pay R10.00
 - If lost the will be R50.00

B: TERMS OF REGISTRATION

The following documents must be furnished by the parent/guardian in order to process registration

- The ID book of a learner/Parent/Guardian's (**Certified Copies**)
- Previous report
- Transfer letter and
- Learner's previous school's Centre Number. Required to finalise the applicant's registration.

1. Admission and registration at Christian High School is at the sole discretion of the governing board. Any learner may be refused registration and the board has no obligation to give reasons for such refusal.
2. Registration is subject to the learner abiding by the rules and regulations of the school which are separate from each other in that if one is deemed illegal and/or unenforceable it has no effect on the rest of the other rules and regulations. Learners and parents/guardians must read the rules and regulations document in the prospectus
3. Attendance of classes and extra classes as per school timetable and/or as instructed by the educator in the school. Learners are required to attend classes regularly and must report to the class teacher if they have to miss classes and/or submit a doctor's/medical certificate if absent due to sickness. If learners are to be absent for any other reason other than being sick/unwell parents must write a letter to the principal or be aware that learners may not be absent for more than 10 consecutive days.
4. Learners are required to wear the prescribed school uniform when attending school (including extra classes) and as determined by the school during excursions, school events and/or tours.
5. The documents supplied to Christian High School are true copies of the originals and were not obtained fraudulently. Christian High School reserves the right to verify the documents with the issuing institution.
6. Cell phones are not allowed at school . If a pupil is in possession of one , the phone will be confiscated and returned upon payment of R200.00.
7. Parent must buy all text books for his/her child/ward before the start of classes. See text book and stationery list.
