

# SCHOOL FEES

- School fees are compulsory.
- The School Governing Body [SGB] sets the school fees for the year at the Annual Budget Meeting held with the Parent Body in October of the previous year.
- **THE FEES FOR THE YEAR 2020 IS R10 000 A YEAR FOR GRADE R , and R8000 for GRADE 1 to GRADE 7**
- The first instalment of school fees should be paid for all new pupils and Grade 1's and Grade R's to ensure a place for the next year. The first instalment of school fees is payable on confirmation of acceptance as numbers are limited in each grade. **The first instalment of school fees will be deducted from the annual school fee.**
- School fees may be paid in full or in 10 monthly instalments from January to 1st October.
- To qualify for a **10% discount**, school fees must be paid in full before the end of February.

Parents guilty of non-payment of school fees will be handed over to an official debt collector appointed by the School Governing Body.

- **Exemption of School Fees** – Applications for Exemption should be made before the end of January of the academic year.

**NOTE:** Parents who have already incurred a debt with the school will not qualify for an

Exemption, to negate the existing debt.

## EXISTING LEARNERS

The first instalment of school fees of **R2500-00** will be collected at the end of each year for the following year. This amount will be deducted from the school fees for the following year. The balance of school fees may be paid in full, before the end of February, to qualify for a 10% discount or paid in 10 monthly instalments from January to October.

Pupils will only be allowed on tours if school fees are paid up to date.
