

AS A PARENT OF RABBONI CHRISTIAN SCHOOL I UNDERTAKE TO:

1. Remember that Rabboni christian school is, in essence, a Christian school and governed by biblical principles and standards.
2. Pray for the principal and staff as they endeavour to use their training and abilities and talents to educate and develop my child toward adulthood and maturity.
3. I will strive to build healthy relations with my child's educators.
4. Support my child in all outreach, academic, cultural and sporting activities, and agree that he/she will take part in all of these activities. I will attend my child's extra-mural activities as often as possible.
5. Support the disciplinary system as set down, in order to train my child according to the word of god to the best of the school's ability. **Nb - rebellion in any form will not be tolerated and I understand that my child may be suspended until his/her behaviour is satisfactory and befitting a christian school. Failing to change a rebellious attitude will ultimately lead to dismissal from this school.**
6. Assist the school in the education of my child by taking an active interest in his/her school work and to co-operate with the staff by signing and returning all relevant correspondence, homework books (sign daily!) Or slips. I undertake to see to it that my child's homework is completed punctually and that his/her school attendance is regular.
7. I will inform the school when my child is ill or absent for any other reason and will provide the necessary doctor's certificate to verify this, as well as a letter written by me.
8. Attend all parents' meetings and functions, except in cases of ill health or unforeseen circumstances, in which instance I will notify the school.
9. Communicate any grievance whatsoever in a christian-like manner with the principal and hod's of the school, (during school hours), and be willing to listen to both sides of the matter before reacting.
10. Uphold at home the christian ethics and morals taught at the school, by setting a godly example to my family.
11. Treat the school property as I would treat my own, as I invest in my child's education.
12. Never use any alcoholic or addictive substances on the school premises.
13. Faithfully pay my child's school fees and honour the contract made by me with the school. I understand that the following school fees are payable monthly, in advance, by the 3rd of each month, including holiday months, for 11 months. Kindly note that fees are calculated over 12 months and divided into 11 monthly payments.
14. Fees for each new year starting January must be paid by 3 January each year
15. I understand that the school fees, as set out below, are calculated for 11 months, payable in monthly instalments for my convenience.

- If you receive your salary on the 15th of every month - payment must be made for the following month (a month in advance). E.g. if you are getting paid on the 15th of December 2019 you have to pay your school fees on the same date for your January 2020 school fees. On the 15th of January 2020, you pay your school fees for February 2020 etc.
- if you receive your salary between the 25th and 30th of every month, your payment must be made for the following month (monthly in advance). E.g. if you are getting paid between the 25th and 30th December 2016 you have to pay your school fees on the same date for your January 2019 school fees etc.

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| <p>16. Discount is given if you pay your school fees 6 or 12 months in advance. Discount will also be given to parents with more than one child in the same family. The first child pays the full amount and for all the other children a 5% discount will be deducted on their monthly fees. This only applies if the full amount is paid before the 3rd of the month. This does not include the crèche and grade R learners. They get breakfast and lunch as part of the school fees. Our account department will assist you to calculate your discount.</p> | |
| <p>17. Exam admission cards will be issued before all exams. These cards will only be issued to learners whose school fees have been paid up-to-date. Without an exam admission card, no learner will be allowed in the exam venue.</p> | |
| <p>18. Exams will last up to and including the last day of each term. One week after the holidays that follow the exams, the report cards will be issued. Report cards will be withheld from learners under the following circumstances when the parents will have to come to school to collect the reports:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School fees are not paid up-to-date; • The learner fails; • Year-end: textbooks have not all been returned to the school. | |
| <p>19. Textbooks will be issued to learners at the beginning of the year. On the last day of the year end of exams, all textbooks must have been handed in. If a textbook is not returned or if it is returned in a bad condition, the learner will have to pay for that book before the report will be given to the student or the parents.</p> | |
| <p>20. The above school fees include all the textbooks, workbooks and affiliation fees of SACSSA and ACSL.</p> | |
| <p>21. Should an account be outstanding after the 3rd of the month when payment was due, the child will be refused admission to classes until the amount is fully paid, including any penalties and interest, and without any prejudice to the school's legal rights or recourse to collect monies due. 10% of penalties will be charged on all outstanding monies. | <p>22. I understand that I will be responsible for all attorneys' charges, including all collection commission and costs of any attorney and client basis, should my account have to be handed over for collection because of non-payment.</p> | |
| <p>23. I will give written notice of one calendar month before my child is taken out of the school. I understand that this period is subject to the discretion of the principal.</p> | |
| <p>24. I agree that should my child leave the school during a calendar month, I will still be responsible for the school fees for the remainder of the month and one month's notice, pending the issue of a report or school leaving certificate.</p> | |
