### SCHOOL FEES FOR 2020

The Governing Body has prepared a detailed budget for 2020, which includes provision for the school fees payable by parents which are required in order to meet budgetary requirements. This budget was presented to parents at a meeting convened on 28 October 2019. Approval for the budget and the proposed school fees was adopted by a resolution voted on by all parents present at the meeting.

**The Junior School and Pre-Primary School's fees for 2020 are accordingly R48 500 per year.** In addition to this, parents are expected to pay for certain textbooks, stationery, sports equipment and all items of school clothing, as well as for camps, music tuition and certain extramural activities available at, or through, the School.

School fees in 2020 will be charged annually in advance and may be paid: 1) by EFT into the School's bank account or preferably by debit order, in ten equal instalments due on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month from February to November, 2) by EFT in 4 equal instalments due on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each term or 3) by EFT in a lump sum by 31 January 2020, in which case a discount of R2 425 will apply. If you wish to switch to debit order, kindly collect the relevant forms from our Bursar.

The School's bank details are as follows: **First National Bank Rondebosch Branch (201509) Account number 5017 0078 429.** Please use your Surname and account number as reference.

All expenses for the forthcoming year were budgeted on a zero basis, i.e. expenses have not been justified by applying a simple inflationary increase to the previous budget. Further, the budget has been based on a high rate of recovery, as has been achieved historically.

The **voluntary contribution** to the Building & Development Fund is R3 250 per family per year. This levy enables the School to grow through various capital development projects, and plan for the future. This is critical to allow us to maintain our position as one of South Africa's finest educational institutions. **Please note the Junior and High School will be collecting separately from 2020.**
